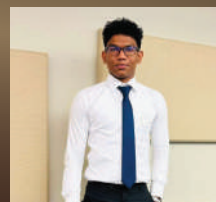

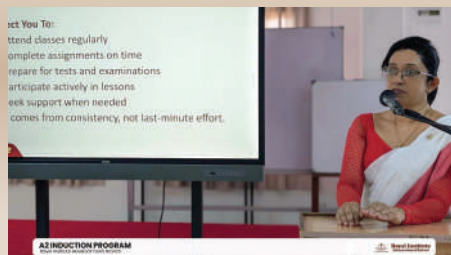
Overall Outstanding Performance

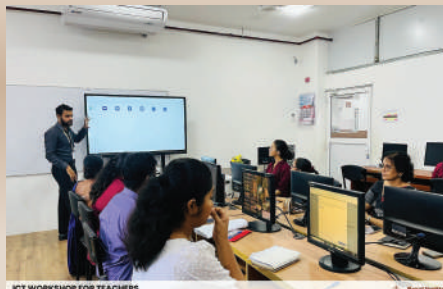

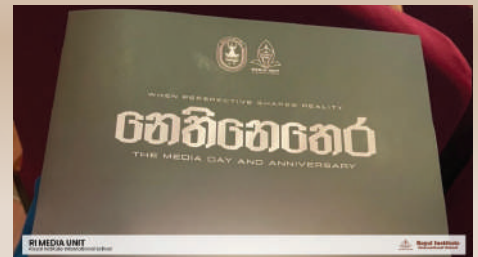

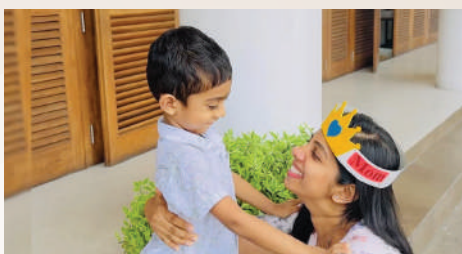

For Ms. Samadhi Athapattu, Mathematics is more than formulas and examinations—it is a subject that builds logical thinking, resilience, patience, and confidence. Her passion for teaching lies in making a meaningful difference in students' lives, particularly by helping those who lack confidence become capable, independent learners through perseverance and consistent effort.

Recognising that many students find Mathematics challenging, she fosters a supportive classroom where mistakes are viewed as opportunities to learn. By celebrating even the smallest achievements, she encourages students to ask questions confidently and develop a positive attitude towards the subject.

As the Head of the Cambridge O Level Mathematics Department, Ms. Samadhi values teamwork among teachers and takes pride in the department's outstanding 100% pass rate in the 2025 Cambridge O Level examination. However, she considers her greatest achievement to be the lasting impact she has on her students. One of her most memorable experiences was guiding a student who believed they would never pass Mathematics to eventually achieve success through patience, encouragement, and determination.

Her hope is that every student leaves her classroom understanding that mistakes are part of learning and that success comes through resilience, consistency, and hard work.

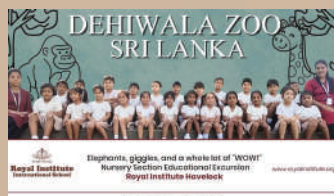
Grade 4 Science Project

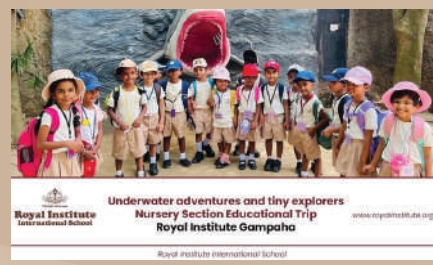
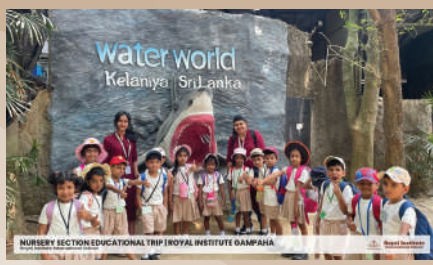
Shadows and Light

ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

Sanithu Hulathduwage

From Royal Institute to AI Innovation

Sanithu reflected on the subjects and teachers who played a significant role in shaping his journey. He shared that ICT was the subject that first showed him what was possible with technology. However, it was Mathematics and the logical thinking it required that prepared him most for software development. He especially credited his Mathematics teacher, Ms Samadhi Athapattu, for encouraging students to understand the reasoning behind answers rather than simply memorising them. According to Sanithu, this approach helped him build the strong analytical foundation that continues to support him today.

When asked what advice he would give current Royal Institute students who aspire to become innovators or entrepreneurs, Sanithu emphasised the importance of taking action before feeling completely prepared. He shared that he built SetFlow between classes, during bus rides to campus, and late at night while walking home from work, all without a team, investors, or external funding. At the same time, he was also building Lilium Labs to serve a different market. Both ventures, he noted, started from zero.

Sanithu encouraged students to focus on solving real problems that they or others around them genuinely experience. He explained that this personal connection to a problem provides the motivation needed to persevere through challenges. He further highlighted that success is not determined by location, sharing that he built products that gained national attention in the United States while living in a small city in Texas that many people in Sri Lanka may not know.

Reflecting on the early days of SetFlow, Sanithu explained that it initially began as a simple task and team management application designed to help him organise his own work. As he continued developing it, he discovered new opportunities and ways to expand the platform far beyond his original vision. He stressed that he started with no coding knowledge, systems knowledge, business plan, or roadmap. Instead, he learned through building, making mistakes, and continuously improving. His message to students was clear: an idea alone has little value without action. Rather than waiting until everything is perfectly planned, he encourages young innovators to take the first step and begin.
